Sha also added that in order for a flourishing anganwadis, you need to instill confidence in the anganwadi workers and not be overpowering.

"Once we have the anganwadi workers in confidence they will automatically ensure that their children will go to these schools," she said.

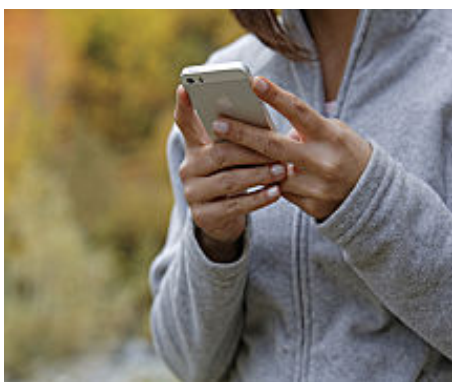
These innovations have helped develop adequate school readiness in pre-school children from anganwadis to enable them to make a smooth transition to primary schooling," said Kanchan Banerjee.
